



Sixth Form Dress Code

All Sixth Formers must wear smart business dress that is suitable for an office environment.

Compulsory – All Students must wear:

A Suit Jacket or Blazer	Suit style and plain. No outside wear is to be worn inside the school building
<i>with</i>	
Shirt and tie or Open necked blouse or Dress	Shirts must be tucked in and ties done up to the neck Blouse should not be low cut or tightly-fitted and must cover the shoulders Dress should be plain and cover the shoulders
<i>And</i>	
Trousers or skirt (unless wearing a dress)	Trousers must be full length Skirts must be appropriate for an office environment and approximately knee length Both should be plain, no denim, no leggings, no extra pockets
Shoes / boots	Must be leather or leather style
School Lanyard and ID card	Must be worn around the neck

Optional – Students can choose to wear:

Jumper	Must be V neck with a collar visible Plain and not sweatshirt or sports style. No zips, no hoods, no pockets
Cardigan	Plain, no zips or hoods
Jewellery	Must be small and kept to a minimum
The wearing of religious garments is allowed	Must be plain

The final decision on what is appropriate dress will rest with the Senior Management Team of the school. Any student who chooses to dress inappropriately may be asked to return home to change.
